

KELLY WINS TWO SILVER FOR USA at VICTORIA GAMES

Fifteen year old Emily Kelly took the 24 hour plus trip to Melbourne, Australia with the United States National Junior Team to compete in the Victorian Championships earlier this month. With many of Australia's top world class swimmers in attendance Emily and the USA squad competed extremely well.

On the first day of the meet Emily was part of a 1-2 USA win taking second in the 1500 with a personal best. Later in the meet Emily had the honor of leading off the USA "B" 800 Free Relay. She had a remarkable swim, taking a second off her previous best time and gaining her second silver medal in the process. Her time 2:03.08 is Emily's second Olympic Trial cut.
