



Long Island Aquatic Club National Level Support Scholarship

For those with the Courage and Determination to be the Best

All Swimmers in the LIAC 13 & Over #1, 13 & Over #2 and Challenge groups are eligible for National Level Support.

Swimmers must be fully committed to the program and have achieved a USA Senior Summer National (or equivalent) time standard, USA Summer Junior National time standard, or National Age Group Top 5 ranking.

Scholarship winners may receive:

- Tuition support for coaching and dryland training (levels vary)
- Free entry fees to USA Swimming National Championships (approx value \$200)
- Travel support to USA Swimming National Championships (levels vary)
- One standard issue of Long Island Aquatic Club gear including warm-up set, suit, 3 T-shirts, and 2 swim caps (approx value \$500)
- **Estimated total value \$1,000 - \$6,000**

ELIGIBILITY

Applicants should be:

- Registered LIAC swimmers
- Aged 12 years and over
- Highly motivated

They should have displayed:

- Exceptional swimming ability
- Potential for further development as competitive swimmers
- Commitment to national-level training program
- Swimmer's family must complete all team policy agreements

The Scholarship is for one year. Scholarship winners **are** eligible to reapply, and Long Island Aquatic Club members **are** eligible to apply. The application package details the scholarship's terms and conditions and requests information on the swimmer applying for the scholarship.

Long Island Swimming is a not-for-profit 501(c)(3) corporation dedicated to the development of competitive swimming on Long Island. Friends of swimming, concerned parents, swimmers, and former swimmers make up its membership. Long Island Swimming is the sponsoring organization for the Long Island Aquatic Club. Long Island Aquatic Club was founded in 1979 and has been the preeminent competitive swimming team on Long Island for over 30 years. United States Swimming recognizes it as one of the USA National Programs of Excellence, achieving Gold Medal status in 2007-2008, '17-'18, '18-'19, '19-'20, '20-'21, '21-'22, '22-'23, the only program on Long Island to achieve this status. LIAC swimmers have represented the United States at the World Championships, Pan-American Championships, Pan-Pac Championships, the World University Games, Junior World Championships, and Junior Pan-Pac Championships. LIAC swimmers and coaches have been named to the United States Swimming National Teams and National Junior Teams.
